DID YOU KNOW?

Say Amen. When we receive communion we say 'Amen', declaring our belief in Jesus being present in the Eucharist. St Augustine suggested that when we receive the host we should say a double amen. "Amen. Yes! I believe this to be not just a piece of bread but the body of Christ." And "Amen. Yes! I believe this to be not just a bunch of people but the body of Christ, a family called to a life of loving unity."
