Verb tenses: simple present and past

Verb tenses tell us when an action happened — present or past.

Examples:

Simple present tense: We swim at the creek. Simple past tense: Two weeks ago, we swam at the creek.

Nova Peris

Nova Peris has many firsts to her name and is a passionate spokeswoman for Indigenous peoples.

Born in Darwin, Nova Peris showed great athletic ability from an early age. She excelled at every sport, including touch football, swimming and cricket. On Saturdays, she ran at Little Athletics meetings and dreamed of one day running at the Olympic Games.

Peris also began playing hockey. She moved to Perth in 1992 to

join the hockey program at the Western Australian Institute of Sport. By this time, Peris had a child. She juggled work, training and bringing up her daughter by herself.

Peris was selected for the national hockey team, the Hockeyroos. At the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games, the Hockeyroos beat South Korea in the final. Peris became the first Indigenous Australian to win an Olympic gold medal.
